

**What is it?**

The Farm Creativity Contest is a province-wide colouring contest that provides children with the opportunity to share what they have learned about agriculture after attending an agriculture education event or fair, a classroom visit or studying a unit on agriculture.

How to enter?

Draw a picture and write about it on the official entry postcard. Mail the entry postcard to Farm & Food Care Ontario. All you need is one regular postage stamp.

Who is eligible?

Kids up to Grade 8 and teachers who teach preschool to Grade 8.

Contest Categories (individual entries):

- i) up to Grade 2
- ii) Grade 3-5
- iii) Grade 6-8

When?

Entries must be postmarked December 1 to be eligible for the calendar year contest.

Where?

Prizes:

There are three prizes for each age category. All prizes are sponsored, in part, by Farm & Food Care Ontario.

Teachers: Each class set submitted is eligible for a random draw to win a cash prize to go toward supplies for your classroom.

Please ensure that the child entering the contest has permission from their parent/guardian or teacher.

Please provide contact information on each entry (a phone number should be included either for the student's home or school; contact information is also required for the classroom portion of the contest). This is important for contacting the winners when the contest is over.
